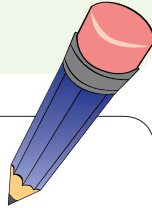




AFTER YOU LEAVE ...

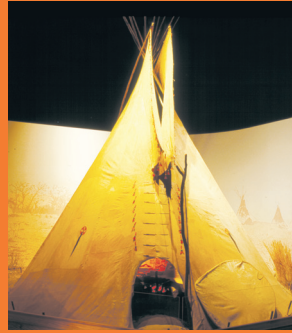
Pretend you are a Wichita Indian living in Kansas long ago. You live where the grass grows very tall. What will you use to build your home?
